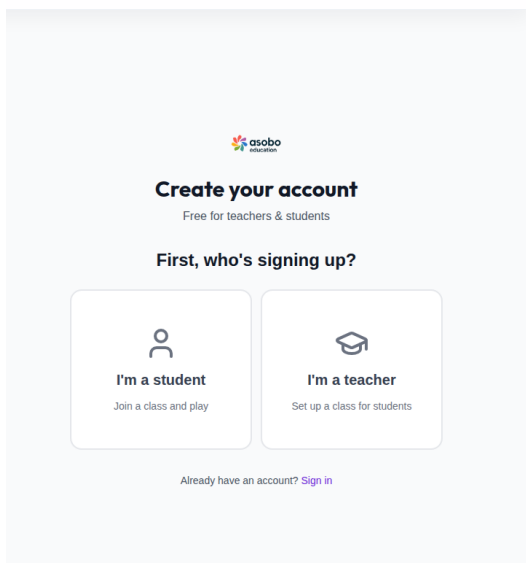

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This guide follows the actual Asobo teacher app, step by step. Sample data only — no real student information.

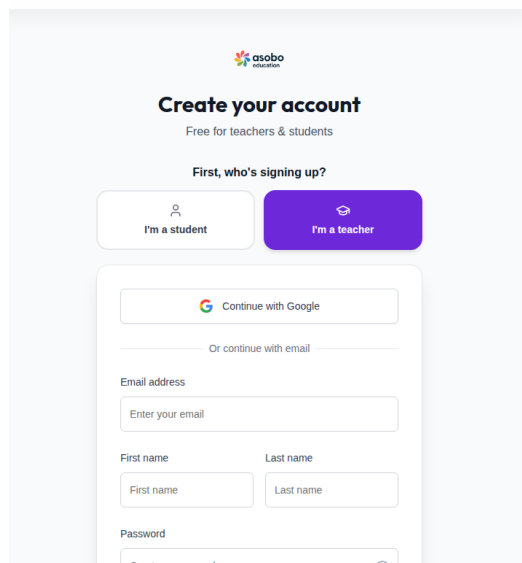
STEP 1

Create your account

New to Asobo? Go to asoboeducation.com and tap Sign Up. It only takes a minute.



First screen: pick "I'm a teacher"



Then fill in your name, email, and a password

THREE QUICK STEPS

- Tap "I'm a teacher."
- Enter your email, name, and a password — or tap "Continue with Google" to skip typing a password.
- Agree to the terms and tap "Create account."

That's it — you're in. Next time, just sign in with the same email and password.

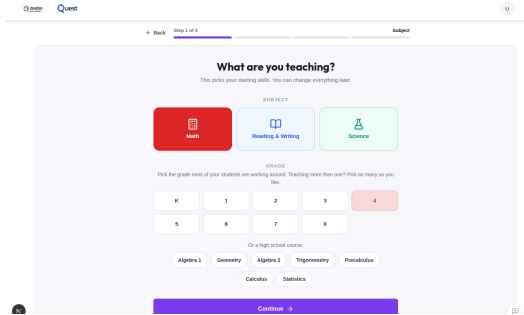
TIP

Using Canvas? You don't need to sign up here — just open Asobo from inside Canvas and you're signed in automatically.

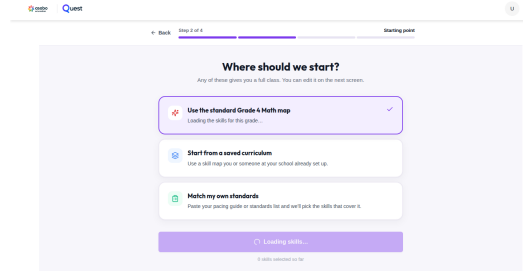
STEP 2

Create your class

The first time you sign in, Asobo walks you through four short screens. Each one asks a single question — answer it and move on. You can change anything later.



Screen 1 — pick a subject and grade



Screen 2 — choose where to start

What are you teaching?

Pick a subject and grade.

2

Where should we start?

Use the standard skill map — most teachers do.

3

Here is your class

Review the skills. Add or remove any.

4

Name it

Give the class a name students will see.

On the last screen, tap "Create my class." That's it — your class exists.

STEP 3

Add your students

Open your class and tap "Add students." This window opens:

Students scan to join instantly

OR INVITE BY NAME / EMAIL

Student name or email + Add

Or show the QR code to scan

FASTEST — SHARE A CODE

- Show the class code on your screen or projector, or share the join link.
- Students type the code (or scan the QR code) and they're in the class instantly.

NO EMAIL NEEDED

- Tap "Set Up Student Logins." Add students by count or by typing their names.
- Asobo makes simple logins: class code + student number. No email or password needed.
- Print the login cards and hand them out.

STEP 4

Choose or assign work

From your class, tap "Assign Quest." You'll see two options:

SKILL CHECK

A quick check to see where students stand before you assign practice.

ASSIGN PRACTICE

Pick a skill or quest and give it to the whole class, or just a few students.

See what you've assigned — who's done, who hasn't started — under "Assignment Management."

TIP

Not sure what to assign? Start with a Skill Check. Asobo shows you the gaps, and suggests what to assign next.

STEP 5

Run a class session

Students join the same way you added them: by code, QR, or their login card. They land on their dashboard, already showing their work.

A 45–60 MINUTE SESSION

- First 5 minutes — show the join code. Students log in as they arrive.
- Next 30–40 minutes — students work at their own pace. Walk the room; the dashboard shows who needs help.
- Last 5–10 minutes — check "Needs attention today" and give one quick group note.

SHARING DEVICES?

- Student logins are built for this — a student logs out, the next one logs in with their own card, in seconds.
- Keep the login cards nearby so a student can rejoin fast on any device.

SLOW INTERNET?

- Have students join one at a time, not all at once — it's easier on your school's network.
- Page stuck? A refresh almost always fixes it. Asobo saves progress as students go.
- Keep the join code visible all period, so anyone who drops off can rejoin without help.

STEP 6

Check progress — and misconceptions

Your dashboard answers one question: who needs you today? Check it mid-class or after the bell.

NEEDS ATTENTION TODAY

Students who haven't logged in, gone quiet, or are struggling on a skill. Tap a name for their full progress.

TOP SKILL GAPS

Ranked by how many students are stuck — with the misconception behind it, when Asobo can tell. This is what to reteach on Monday.

COLOR CODE, EVERYWHERE

● Struggling ● Building ● Secure

A reminder: *Asobo supports your judgment — it doesn't replace it. The dashboard tells you where to look. You decide what to do.*
